### Our Camps

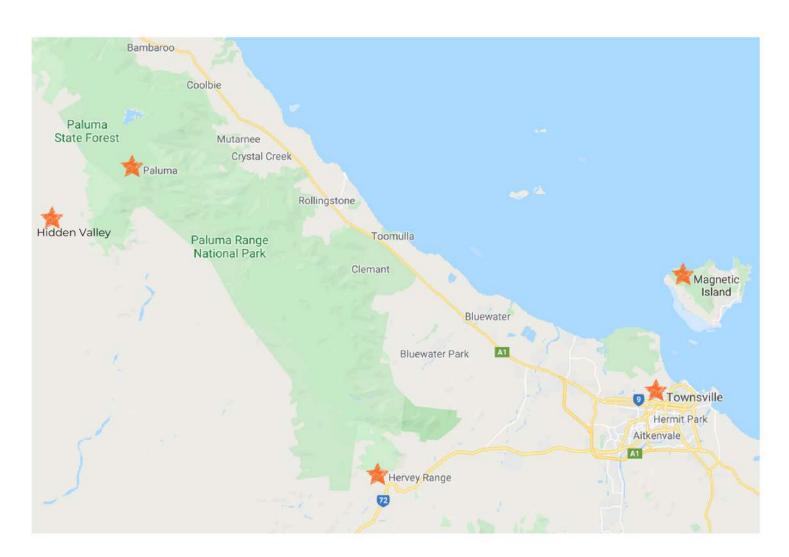

#### **OUR LOCATIONS**

- **Paluma** The Outer Limits Adventure Centre is located in Paluma Village, where we have our high ropes course. All water activities are held at the Paluma Dam.
- **Townsville** Our activities can be held in various locations around Townsville depending on the type of activity. These include Pallarenda, The Strand, Riverway and Mount Stuart
- **Hervey's Range** A great overnight camp option with high ropes, abseiling and team activities
- Magnetic Island Our activities are generally based around Picnic Bay and Horseshoe Bay, however, other locations are also available
- Hidden Valley For the more adventurous groups, a true Aussie Outback experience



### General Information

- Although we can cater to your individual requirements, we strongly recommend that groups are capped at 20 participants. However, some activities do allow for up to 25 people to participate at once.
- Most activity sessions run for 1.5 hours. Abseiling and High Ropes generally run for 3 hours
- We conduct Risk Assessments for all activities and can provide the documents upon request.
- Our Paluma, Hidden Valley and Hervey's Range camps are ideal locations for multi day camps.
- We will provide you with a personalised itinerary and, if required, can arrange all bus and ferry services.

#### KAYAKING

 Description: The picture perfect Paluma Dam is a short, 20 minute drive from Paluma Village and is an ideal location for watersports. Together we will learn how to paddle a kayak and explore the banks.

#### STAND UP PADDLE BOARDING

### Wilderness Camps

#### OUTER LIMITS ADVENTURE CENTRE, PALUMA



#### WILDERNESS CAMPS

- Age: Suited for grade 7 to 12
- Group size: Maximum 60 participants (3 groups of 20 participants).
- Activities: Bushwalking, Camping, High Ropes, Archery Tag, Mountain Biking, Kayaking, Stand
   Up Paddle Boarding, Raft Building
- · Quotes are inclusive of:
  - Accommodation in tents (sleeping bags not included), all meals, activity equipment, 1–2
     Outer Limits guides per group, all risk assessments, detailed itinerary, participant equipment list, food plan
- Option to facilitate workshops in school to prepare students (additional cost)

The journey based wilderness camp takes participants on a 4 day and 3 night adventure through the World Heritage listed rainforest of Paluma Range National Park. Spending one day at the Adventure Centre in Paluma Village, climbing on the high ropes and low ropes course, playing archery tag and walking to hidden waterfalls for a swim. A 17km hike takes the group through the rainforest, past historic tin mining sites and stunning waterfalls and to the DCK Shelter, where the group will spend the night. The following day a 5km hike brings the group to the Paluma Dam where they spend the day on the water, kayaking, SUPing and raft building. Dinner will be served by the campfire followed by roasting marshmallows for desert. The next day a 17km mountain bike ride will bring the group back to Paluma Village.

All 3 groups will be on their own individual journey with different starting points. The groups will not get to see each other until the last day of camp. A BBQ lunch is held at the Adventure Centre with the whole group to finish the camp and exchange stories.

- Duration: 3 day, 2 nights
- Activities: Bushwalking, Camping, High Ropes, Archery Tag, Kayaking, Stand Up Paddle Boarding, Raft Building

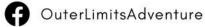
The Adventure Camps are well suited for smaller and younger groups. The Adventure Centre in Paluma will be home base for 3 days and 2 nights. Day one will be spent on the high ropes course, including the low ropes, leap of faith, glider possum and rock climbing. In the afternoon the group sets out on a bushwalk to a nearby waterfall for a refreshing swim. The next day the group heads out to Paluma Dam for water activities. On the last day, we play a few games of archery tag.
